



MINUTES OF THE WORK- SESSION OF THE TOLEDO CITY COUNCIL
Budget Discussion
1007 S. PROSPECT DRIVE, TOLEDO IA AT 5:00 P.M.

The meeting began at 5:00 p.m. with Mayor Brian Sokol present and presiding. Answering roll call for the City of Toledo were Boll, Goodhart, Pansegrau, Cook and Vesely. No others were present.

Budget discussion began with wage increases, after much discussion it was recommended 7% wage increases for all employees. Employee insurance benefits were discussed and recommended to look at other potential plans during the upcoming year. After reviewing the police budget, it was recommended the current proposed budget could include a shift differential and additional ammo purchases without additional funding. It was also recommended to remove the Tahoe purchase from the current budget due to placement timing of the 2023 Tahoe.

Boll motioned to adjourn, seconded by Goodhart. All present voiced ayes, motion carried and meeting adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
