MINUTES OF THE TOLEDO COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING HELD AT THE REINIG CENTER, 1007 S. PROSPECT DRIVE, TOLEDO IA STARTING AT 5:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order at 5:01 p.m. with Mayor Sokol present and presiding. Answering roll call for the City of Toledo were Boll, Goodhart, and Pansegrau. Cook and Cremeans were absent. Others present were McAdoo, Jordan, and Rusty & Cara Doud.

Under new business, Mayor Sokol opened the discussion on Woodlawn covenants. The city engineer had sent comments on the final draft and each of those were reviewed by the council.
